Dear All Residents of RiverWoods Durham, RiverWoods Exeter and Birch Hill,

We have great news to share with all residents.

On Wednesday, Birch Hill received its second straight week of 100% negative testing results, clearing its health center from “outbreak status.” Going forward Birch Hill’s health care center will be tested under the state’s standard “surveillance” program. This also allows Birch Hill’s health care residents to begin receiving outside visitors. This is great news for residents and their families.

Additionally, RiverWoods Exeter has received all of its results from the last round of testing, and the results were 100% negative, including the staff member who initially tested positive.

So, as of today we stand 100% negative across all communities. That is great news!

The state continues to stay steady and persistently low in terms of new cases, with an average of approximately 33 cases per day over the past seven days. As a state we are testing about 600 more people per day on average than in the prior month, and our percentage of positive tests has not increased in any significant way.

Even with all of this good news we need to stay vigilant about safety; so wash your hands, keep your social circle small, do your best to keep a 6-foot distance from others, and wear your mask when you are around others.
